OBLIGATIONS UPON RECEIVING A GRANT

Grant recipients are required to submit a Final Grant Report to FCSS by December 15th of current year. This report must reflect the application information previously submitted. Failure to submit a Final Report on time may affect future applications to the FCSS Grant Program.

WHAT IS THE FCSS COMMUNITY GRANT PROGRAM:

The FCSS Grant Program provides funds to enhance and enrich preventative programs and services throughout the County of Wetaskiwin. FCSS is a partnership between the County of Wetaskiwin and the Province of Alberta. Funding decisions will be made in accordance with provincial FCSS guidelines.

Application Deadline is March 31st.

Funds are disbursed in May.

Project must be completed by December 1st.

Final Report is due by December 15th.

Unused funds must be returned by December 15th.
