

## WATER WELL DRILLING RIGS

(Permit required for each move \$20/permit)

Water Well Drilling Rigs are unable to run below 100% weight. For this reason, a permit must be obtained for each location.

1. The permit will be valid for the trip into location and out.
2. Road Use Agreement required for each project.
3. **When Seasonal Road Bans are in effect** all bans must be strictly adhered to; thereby any project permit is suspended during road bans.
4. **When Seasonal Road Bans** are no longer in effect in the County of Wetaskiwin, the User shall be permitted to haul as follows:
  - A. 100% weight on roads.
5. Provincial legislation states that all tridem axle groups are regulated while operating on ANY County road unless the user possess a valid provincial TAC permit. TAC permits can be obtained from the Province of Alberta that will allow the user to haul the maximum allowable weights as determined by the general conditions of the permit. The County of Wetaskiwin will recognize and allow anyone that has a valid TAC permit to haul at the maximum allowable weights of the permit.(subject to road restrictions)  
Provincial legislation states that Tri-drive axle groups are regulated while operating on ANY County road unless the user possess a valid provincial TAC permit AND a valid provincial tri-drive permit which will determine the maximum allowable weights. The County of Wetaskiwin will recognize and allow anyone that has a valid TAC permit AND a valid Tri-drive permit to haul at the maximum allowable weights of the permit.(subject to road restrictions)  
**Provincial permits may be obtained by calling 1-800-662-7138.**
6. Each Contractor/Company **MUST** phone Roadata Services Ltd. to obtain a permit for the haul.
7. Signs must be posted warning vehicle traffic of possible hazard due to slippery or rough conditions.
8. The User agrees to indemnify and save harmless the County of Wetaskiwin No. 10 from and against all loss, costs, charges, damages and expenses which the County of Wetaskiwin No. 10 may suffer or sustain as a result of the operations of the User on County roads or on leases accessing these County roads, excepting any loss, costs, charges, damages and expenses, caused by the willful misconduct or negligence of the County.
9. The User will contribute to any patching or grading work required in excess of the regular scheduled maintenance on an ongoing basis.
10. The User agrees to cease all hauling during periods of heavy rain or when road is in poor condition.
11. The User agrees to leave the road safe at all times.
12. Blocking of County roads will not be permitted under any circumstances. Through traffic must be maintained at all times.
13. The User shall provide a contact name and telephone number in the event that the County has any issues or inquiries about this project.
14. The User agrees to pay for any repairs to road damage caused by their operations; over and above normal wear and tear. **Should damage be caused to the roads, the User shall cease operations immediately and notify the County.**
15. User shall inspect road ways prior to use. Any defects shall be reported prior to use to the following:

**Defects to road way not reported shall become the responsibility of the permit user.**
