COMMUNITY PEACE OFFICER LIVING ALLOWANCE SUBSIDY #2104

POLICY STATEMENT

The Council of the County of Wetaskiwin No. 10 recognizes the limitations faced by Community Peace Officers in attempting to locate acceptable housing in rural areas designated by the living restrictions. It is Council's intent to relieve the financial burden of establishing a residence within the living restriction boundaries and attempt to secure the longevity of Community Peace Officers, by providing a living allowance for those Community Peace Officers with living restrictions as a condition of employment.

PROCEDURES

The Community Peace Officers who, as a condition of employment, are required to reside within a specific geographical area within the County of Wetaskiwin, shall be eligible for a living allowance subsidy, in the amount of \$150.00 per month. Eligibility requirements shall include residential compliance within the specified geographical area. Compliance with the living restriction shall be confirmed by the Assistant Chief Administrative Officer. Prior to reviewing the living allowance subsidy, issues or concerns regarding lack of available housing within a specific geographical area shall be addressed in writing to the Assistant Chief Administrative Officer. All issues shall be addressed by the Assistant Chief Administrative Officer in conjunction with the County Administrator.

Living allowance subsidies awarded to Community Peace Officers, shall be included on the Community Peace Officers monthly pay.

The living allowance is a taxable benefit and therefore subject to deductions as set out by the Canada Revenue Agency.

This policy shall be effective March 1, 2005.
