Solid waste facility user identification cards (Green Cards) have and are being issued to County residents in an effort to eliminate use by residents of non-contributing municipalities. You can obtain a card at the County office or the solid waste facilities upon proof of residency. Waste will not be accepted without a "GREEN CARD".

| <u>PEACE HILLS TRANSFER STATION</u> SW 29-46-24-W4M (Division 3) - 2 miles north of Hwy 13 on RR 245 | OPEN: MAY TO OCTOBER Sat. 9 am - 5 pm, Wed. 12 noon - 8 pm NOVEMBER TO APRIL Wed. & Sat. 9 am - 5 pm | Accepts bagged household garbage, general waste - one ton maximum, double rinsed pesticide containers, oil & oil filters |
| <u>EAST MILLET TRANSFER STATION</u> NW 28-47-24-W4M (Division 4) - 3/4 miles east of Millet on Hwy 2A on SH Access 814 | OPEN: Tues. & Sat. 9 am - 5 pm Thurs. 12 noon - 8 pm | Accepts bagged household garbage & general waste - one ton maximum |
| <u>MULHURST BAY TRANSFER STATION</u> NW 7-47-27-W4M (Division 5) - 1/2 mile south of SH 616 on RR 280 | OPEN: Tues. & Sat. 9 am - 5 pm | Accepts bagged household garbage, general waste - one ton maximum, wire (posts removed), tires (passenger vehicles only), appliances, trees & shrubs (no stumps), scrap metal |
| <u>LAKEDELL TRANSFER STATION</u> NE 15-46-1-W5M (Division 5) - 1/2 mile north of Hwy 13 on RR 12 | OPEN: Mon., Wed., & Sat. 9 am - 5 pm | Accepts bagged household garbage, general waste - one ton maximum, wire (posts removed), tires (passenger vehicles only), appliances, trees & shrubs (no stumps), double rinsed pesticide containers, scrap metal |

| <u>WEST BUCK LAKE TRANSFER STATION</u> SE 36-45-7-W5M (Division 7) - 1/2 mile south of Jct. Hwy 13 & 22, 1/4 mile west | OPEN: Tues. & Sat. 9 am - 5 pm | Accepts bagged household garbage, general waste - one ton maximum, wire (posts removed), tires (passenger vehicles only), appliances, trees & shrubs (no stumps), scrap metal |

6 lbs. to 100 lbs. - \$5.00

RESIDENTIAL & COMMERCIAL - General Waste will be accepted at the following rates:
RESIDENTIAL: \$50.00 - 1 ton
n/c - less than 1 ton
COMMERCIAL: \$50.00 - 1 ton
n/c - less than 1 ton
Clean untreated wood (free of chemicals, nails, etc.) 1 ton or more: \$50.00/load
