AGRICULTURAL BURSARIES POLICY #6221

POLICY STATEMENT

Annually, three (3) \$500.00 agricultural bursaries will be made available by the County of Wetaskiwin to any qualifying applicant who wishes to attend a post secondary institution in a faculty relating to agriculture.

PROCEDURES

1. The applicant must be a resident of the County of Wetaskiwin No. 10 or of a municipality with coterminous boundaries such as the Town of Millet, City of Wetaskiwin or the Summer Villages. Should there not be enough funding budgeted for all applicants, the County of Wetaskiwin residents will take precedence.
2. The applicant must be registered in a post secondary institution in a faculty relating to agriculture.
3. The applicant must provide a copy of the letter of acceptance from the post secondary institution for the current year.
4. The applicant's participation in agricultural and/or community activities is desirable, e.g. participation in agricultural fairs, 4-H memberships, etc.
5. Deadline for applications is October 1st of each year. Application will be reviewed by the ASB Committee at the first meeting following the deadline.
