***CROP DAMAGE DUE TO BORROW AREAS REQUIRED FOR
ROAD CONSTRUCTION AND/OR MAINTENANCE
Policy #3217***

POLICY STATEMENT

The Council of the County of Wetaskiwin No. 10 recognizes that crop damage may occur in association with borrow pits and landscape borrows required for fill materials during road construction and/or road maintenance.

PROCEDURES

1. Prior to the work being started, the Project Supervisor shall approach the landowner and request permission for access to borrow materials and determine the associated crop damage compensation.
2. The Project Supervisor shall determine the scope of work which will be completed by the County (County forces or Contractors) and the compensation for crop damage.
3. The Project Supervisor will complete a Right of Entry setting out the name and address of the landowner, legal land description, size of borrow and access, variety of crop to be damaged, compensation, including fence erection or repair as required and any other relevant information and ensure the Right of Entry is properly executed by the landowner.
4. A copy of the signed Right of Entry will be mailed or delivered to the landowner for his/her records.
5. The Project Supervisor will proceed with the required work, ensuring the terms and conditions as set out in the Right of Entry are adhered to.
6. The County will compensate the landowner 1.5 times the crop insurance yield based on Appendix A (attached). The commodity price shall be established during the year in which the crop damage occurs using the commodity prices from the Wetaskiwin Seed and Grain Co-operative Plant.
