Clean Burnable Materials: trees, untreated wood (does not include stumps)

Scrap Metal: machinery parts, other large metal objects

Tires: all automotive tires with the rims removed

Wire: spooled, posts removed

ALL TRANSFER SITES – Wastes Accepted include:

Household garbage: all garbage produced from the home must be bagged.

FEES:

General Waste (Truck Size):

- Less than 1 Ton: no charge
- 1 Ton: \$50.00
The definition of a 1 Ton load is "a vehicle that contains more than a two foot depth of waste (not bagged)".
- Burnable wood over a 1 ton load \$50.00
- Refrigerators, Freezers (Freon removal charge): \$25.00
- Refrigerators, Freezers (proof of Freon removal): \$5.00
- All other white appliances (stoves, washers, dryers): \$5.00
- Propane Cylinders:
 - 5 Pounds or Less no charge
 - 100 Pounds or Less \$5.00
 - More than 100 Pounds not accepted
- Tires no charge
- Wire (Spooled with Posts Removed only) no charge
(If wire is not rolled with posts removed material will be rejected.)
- Scrap Metal no charge

ECO STATION:

The City of Edmonton has invited the County residents to make use of its ECO Station located at:

5150 99 Street, Edmonton

Hours of Operation: Tuesday thru Saturday – 9:00 a.m. – 4:30 p.m.

(The only entrance to the ECO Station is on 99 Street between the Edmonton Power Facility and South Side Welding).

Bring clearly marked household hazardous waste products (paints, wood preservatives, herbicides, solvents, paint strippers, old camp fuel, used antifreeze and oil).

There is no charge for disposing residential hazardous wastes and recyclables, but there will be fees (cash only) for some materials (fridges, stoves). No hazardous waste from commercial business will be accepted. Please note that hazardous waste from farms, agricultural operations and all types and sizes of businesses are not accepted at this facility.
