## **ERECTING CAUTIONARY SIGNS POLICY #3207**

### **POLICY STATEMENT**

The County of Wetaskiwin shall provide and erect signage advising motorists of the need to proceed with caution when children or facilities for children are in the immediate area.

"PLAYGROUND" and "CHILDREN PLAYING" cautionary signs shall be available for placement along County roads for residents with children, in the following situations:

1. Along thoroughfare roads which pass through Hamlets;
2. High density subdivisions;
3. All playground located along County roads;
4. Visibility is limited along a roadside in an area where children reside.
5. Yardsites which are generally located on opposite sides of the road (e.g. each site has occupied residences or an individual has a split yard set up);

### **PROCEDURES**

Upon notification of the need to erect a cautionary sign through a hamlet, high density subdivision or new a playground, the Superintendent, Public Works shall inspect the area and, if warranted, shall direct the Public Works Crew to proceed with the installation of the designated signage.

Families residing within the County, who request cautionary signage for the sole benefit of their families, and upon written request to the Superintendent, Public Works or other delegated authority, may have cautionary signs installed by the County of Wetaskiwin. All costs for signs erected pursuant to this clause shall be the responsibility of the individual submitting the request. Such individuals shall pre-pay the cost of the sign prior to installation.
