A **Public Hearing** will be held on Tuesday, April 7 at 9:15 am. All Public Hearings are open to the public and attendance either in person or virtually is encouraged. Written and verbal comments may be given at the Public Hearing.

**Purpose of the Public Hearing:** a Public Hearing will be held before Council to review proposed bylaw 2026/16. The proposed text amendments include the following:

- Addition of Data Processing Facility (Data Centre) to Section 15 *Terms and Words*. “Data Processing Facility (Data Centre) means a facility used primarily for the processing, storage, transmission, or management of digital data, including associated servers, cooling systems, electrical infrastructure, backup power generation, and ancillary equipment.”
- Data Processing Facility (Data Centre) as a discretionary use in both the Agricultural and Industrial land use districts
- Data Processing Facility under Land Use Bylaw Section 9 – Specific Use Regulations and Information requirements. This section would specify the applicability of the section, Development Permit Duration, Site Design and Landscaping, Information Requirements, Noise and Nuisance Mitigation, Setbacks, Sensitive Uses, and Alberta Utilities Commission Approval.

- Written comments will form part of the submission and be presented at the Hearing.
- Submissions must be related to the topic of the Public Hearing.
- Council may determine speaking time limits.
