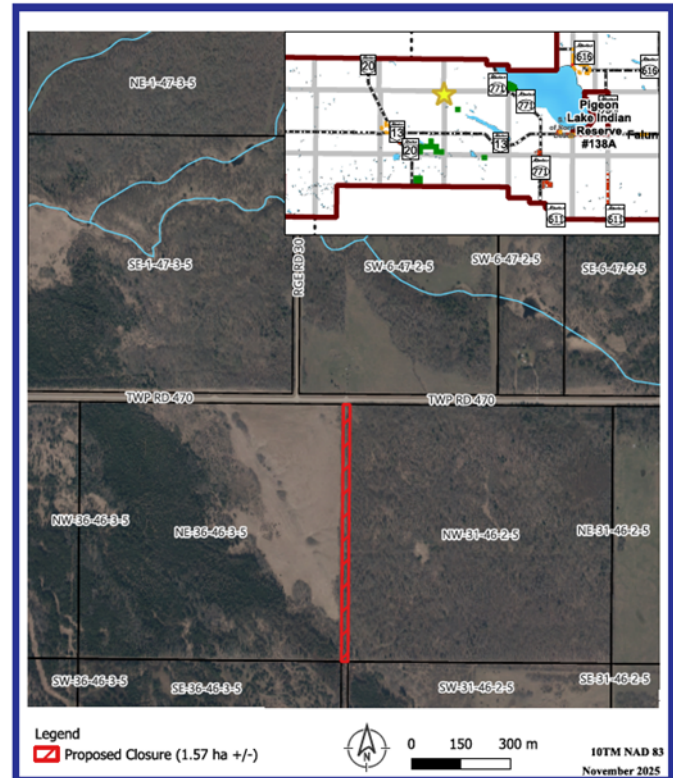
A Public Hearing will be held on Tuesday, May 19, 2026, at 9:15 a.m. All Public Hearings are open to the public and attendance either in person or virtually is encouraged. Written and verbal comments may be given at the Public Hearing.

Purpose of the Public Hearing: under authority of Sections 18, 22, 27 and 230 of the Municipal Government Act, being Chapter M-26 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta 2000 and amendments thereto, it is the intention of the County of Wetaskiwin No. 10 to seek input regarding the introduction of a bylaw whereby the road allowance between **NE-36-46-3-W5M** and **NW-31-46-2-W5M** be closed to public travel and **sold**.
