Title Grants to Organizations

1. Policy Statement:

- 1.1. The County believes that certain amounts of money should be included in its Municipal Budget each year for payments of grants to certain charitable organizations, cemeteries, institutions and societies.

2. Guidelines:

- 2.1. The grant money shall be determined by Council each year through budget to include:
