- E-waste Recycling (TV's, Computers, tablets, printers & accessories)
- Paint Recycling (includes aerosols)
- Pesticide Chemical Containers (triple rinsed)
- Agricultural Plastics (Plastic twine, silage covers, grain bags)
- Appliances
- Metal (includes hot water tanks, scrap metal, bicycles)
- Propane Cylinders (all sizes accepted)
- Tires (no rims)
- Wire (spooled with posts removed)

Garbage Accepted:

- Household garbage (bagged and tied)
- Hot Water Tanks
- Plastics
- Scrap Metal
- Paint cans (empty/dry)
- Motors (gas & electric)
- Pumps
- Microwaves
- Hot tubs
- Bicycles
- Lawn mowers
- Rototillers
- Furniture, including beds, chairs, couches, tables, dressers, toilets, basins, sinks, etc.
- Trees & Shrubs (no stumps)
- Ashes (bagged or boxed)
- Wood (clean burnable untreated)
- Barbeques
- Shingles
- Demolition/Renovation (residential)

Not Accepted:

- Animal waste or carcasses
- Grains or seeds
- Toxic weeds
- Liquid waste; oil, oil filters, pesticides, antifreeze, camping fuel or flammable liquids, toxic liquids, sewage
- Cement/concrete or rocks

Accepted at Gwynne, Mulhurst Bay, Lakedell, Buck Lake	
Refrigerators, freezers, stoves, washers, dryers, dishwashers, air conditioners, refrigerated units	\$20
Propane Cylinders:	
Accepted at Buck Lake, Gwynne, Lakedell, Mulhurst Bay	
All sizes accepted	No Charge
Tires	No Charge
Accepted at Buck Lake, Gwynne, Lakedell, Mulhurst Bay, Winfield	
Wire ² (rolled and removed from posts)	No Charge
Accepted at Gwynne, Mulhurst Bay, Lakedell, Buck Lake	
Scrap Metal	No Charge
Accepted at Gwynne, Mulhurst Bay, Lakedell, Buck Lake	
Recycling	
Each transfer station may accept different commodities such as newsprint, mixed paper, paint, chemical containers, used oil & filters, e-waste.	No Charge
Town of Millet ³	\$20 per any portion, up to a standard pick-up truck box

¹ All household waste is to be bagged.

² Wire that is not removed from posts and secured in neat rolls will be rejected.

³ Individual loads larger than standard pick-up truck box will not be accepted from Town of Millet Residents.
