



## Council Meeting Highlights

October 4, 2022

### Administration:

- Summer Villages of Crystal Springs & Grandview Request for Meeting
  - Council moved to advise the Summer Villages that Range Road 12 is maintained as per Gravel Road Maintenance Requirements Policy 3205 and requested that the Summer Village of Grandview and Crystal Springs provide a list of topics to discuss, background information and possible alternatives, costs and funding models prior to organizing a meeting.
- Scotties Tournament of Hearts – Sponsorship Opportunity
  - Council recommended the Wetaskiwin Curling Club apply to the Zone 1 Recreation Funding for the 2023 Scotties Tournament of Hearts Women's Provincial Curling Championship.
- Penalty Cancellation and Tax Forgiveness
  - As per section 347(1) of the *Municipal Government Act*, Council approved the request for the cancellation of the penalties in the amount of \$1,433.26
- Range Road 11 Local Improvement Bylaw 2022/54 – Dorchester Golf
  - Council provided three readings to Bylaw 2022/54 for the purpose of Local Improvement Tax and Borrowing for the paving of Range Road 11 south of Highway 13 - Dorchester Golf
- Range Road 11 Local Improvement Bylaw 2022/55 – General
  - Council provided three readings to Bylaw 2022/55 for the purpose of Local Improvement Tax and Borrowing for the paving of Range Road 11 south of Highway 13.
- Range Road 11 Local Improvement Bylaw 2022/53 – Whispering Spruce
  - Council provided three readings to Bylaw 2022/53 for the purpose of Local Improvement Tax and Borrowing for the paving of Range Road 11 south of Highway 13 – Whispering Spruce.
- Bylaw Enforcement Officer Position Appointment
  - Council appointed Ms. Jennifer Anchan as a Bylaw Enforcement Officer for the County of Wetaskiwin No. 10.
- Alder Flats Special Tax Bylaw 2022/52
  - Council provided three reading to Bylaw 2022/52 for the purpose of to authorize a special tax to raise revenue to pay for connections of private properties to local wastewater collection lines within the Hamlet of Alder Flats.

### Leisure and Community Services

- Leisure & Community Services Quarterly Report
  - Camping Revenue is down from last year due increased fuel costs and number of rain days in June.
  - Docks have been removed at Twin Lakes, Battle Lake, Mound Red, Mulhurst Bay Boat Launch, Coal Lake.
  - Ice has been installed at the Winfield Arena.
  - Administration is investigating a more cost-effective option to replace the parking pay terminal at Mulhurst Bay with a "Scan-to-Pay".
  - The consulting team held an open house round table session at the Lakedell Ag Society on September 8, 2022.
- Contract Renewal – Mound Red Park
  - Council approved to extend the Mound Red Park Contract in the name of Greg Buck for an additional one-year term effective May 1st, 2023, to September 15th, 2023, with the option of a one-year extension with an annual contract amount of \$15,000.00 and an hourly rate for other work or extension of contract of \$15.00 per hour; and that Administration prepare an RFP for the 2024 season.
- Contract Renewal – Twin Lakes Park
  - Council approved to extend the Twin Lakes Park Contract in the name of Carson Colby for an additional one-year term effective May 1st, 2023, to September 30th, 2023, with the option of a

one-year extension with an annual contract amount of \$22,000.00 and an hourly rate for other work or extension of contract of \$20.00 per hour and approve the request from Administration to Sole Source Carson Colby to operate the Battle Lake Campground for a one-year term effective May 1st, 2023, to September 30th, 2023, with the option of a one-year extension with an annual contract amount of \$22,000.00 and an hourly rate for other work or extension of contract of \$20.00 per hour.

Planning and Development

- Proposed Rezoning Maywood Community Centre
  - Council provided First Reading to Bylaw 2022/48 for the purpose of reclassified 1.21 hectares within SE 6-46-5-W5M from Institutional (IS) to Rural Residential (RR).
- Municipal Development Plan (MDP) Review
  - Council accepted the update respecting the Initial Draft Municipal Development Plan (MDP) as presented by Municipal Planning Services (MPS) as information and further direct Administration to release and disseminate the Initial Draft MDP to the public for review.
- Proposed Subdivision within SE 15-46-6-W5M
  - Council approved proposed Subdivision Application RW/22/19 (MPS File #22-R-580) within SE 15-46-6-W5M, subject to nine (9) conditions.
