Public Hearing Scheduled for Proposed New Land Use Bylaw

For Immediate Release – The County of Wetaskiwin will hold a Public Hearing to gather feedback on the proposed new Land Use Bylaw on Tuesday, December 17, 2024, at 10:00 a.m. in the County Council Chambers, located at 243019A Highway 13, Wetaskiwin, Alberta.

The Public Hearing is an opportunity for individuals who believe they are affected by the proposed Bylaw to share their views. Participants may attend in-person or virtually and provide input either verbally or through written submissions.

Details for Participation:

- **In-Person Attendance:** Persons wishing to speak at the Public Hearing may attend without prior notification. The Council Meeting will already be in progress starting at 9:00 a.m., so attendees are asked to enter quietly and be seated in the gallery with minimal disruption.
- **Virtual Attendance:** To join online, visit www.county.wetaskiwin.ab.ca/731/Council-Meetings or call the County Office at 780-352-3321 for assistance.
- **Written Submissions:** Written submissions related to the Land Use Bylaw may be submitted prior to the hearing. These submissions will form part of the public record and will be presented at the hearing. Written submissions must address the topic of the Public Hearing.
- **Speaking Guidelines:** Each speaker will have one opportunity to present for up to five (5) minutes, excluding responses to questions from Council at the conclusion of their presentation. A second opportunity may be granted, time permitting, after everyone has had a chance to speak and at the discretion of the Chair.

The County of Wetaskiwin values public input and encourages all interested individuals to participate in this important process.
