

BY-LAW NUMBER 2005/16

BY-LAW NO. 2005/16 is a by-law of the County of Wetaskiwin No. 10 in the Province of Alberta, for the purpose of a Text Amendment to the Village at Pigeon Lake Area Structure Plan in SE 14-46-1-W5M.

WHEREAS: Section 191 of the Municipal Government Act, 2000, Chapter M-26, allows for the amendments of by-laws.

AND WHEREAS: notification and procedural requirements outlined in Section 230 and 606 of the Municipal Government Act, 2000, Chapter M-26 have been met.

NOW THEREFORE: The Council of the County of Wetaskiwin No. 10, hereby enacts as follows:

1. By-law 2005/16 is a By-law within the County of Wetaskiwin No. 10 for the purpose of a text amendment to Area Structure Plan By-law 97/58 and amending By-law 2004/10 - SE 14-46-1-W5M (Village at Pigeon Lake), is further amended by deleting sections 5.11, 5.12, and 5.13 and substituting:

"5.11 Lots under 4,000m² (one acre or less) in size, which are contiguous or separated by a road, lane, park or watercourse will be served by a sewage gathering system as required by the Municipal Development Plan and County Policy 6611 regarding Sewer Systems for new multi-lot subdivisions. This will also apply to lots of between 4,000m² and 10,000m² (one acre to 2.471 acres) unless the lot is at least 40m wide and contains an area of at least 1,850 m² in which the shallow water table is at least two metres below the ground surface.

5.12 Lots larger than one acre may use on-site sewage disposal or pump-and-haul as allowed by the Alberta Private Sewage System Standard of Practice 1999 or its successor in place at the time of development.

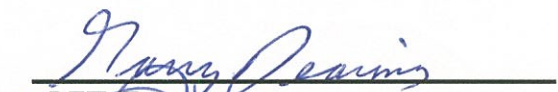
5.13 The County's cost of expanding or constructing a sewer lagoon to handle the additional load may be recovered through an off-site levy bylaw.


2. This By-law comes into effect on the date of third and final reading.
