

Notice to Residents of Curilane Beach and the Hamlet of Mulhurst Bay, County of Wetaskiwin No. 10

RE: CURBSIDE GARBAGE PICK UP

This pick up is for household waste only and does not include items such as lawn clippings, leaves and trimmings, construction debris or ashes.

Residents will be required to transport all non-household waste to a County operated solid waste transfer site. The nearest transfer site is Mulhurst Bay Solid Waste Transfer Station located on NW 7-47-27-W4M which is approximately ½ mile south of Secondary Highway 616 on Range Road 280. The site is open year round Tuesdays & Saturdays, 9:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. and additionally on Thursdays during the months of May 1 to September 30 from 12:00 noon to 8:00 p.m.

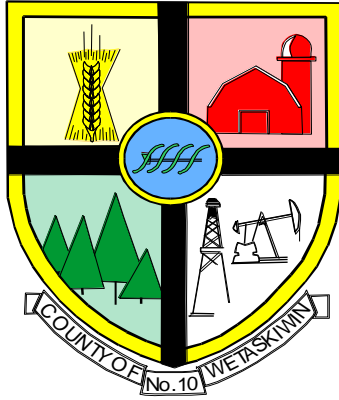
All household waste must be:

- Bagged (plastic garbage bags, not shopping bags or cardboard boxes).
- Contained in either a metal or plastic containers with lids,
 - in a manner to be protected from animals
- Each household is allowed a maximum of four (4) receptacles
 - not to exceed 121 liters capacity and
 - a maximum of 25 kg (55 lbs) per receptacle,
- Placed at the curb by 7:00 a.m. on Tuesday.

Any waste not meeting the above guidelines will not be picked up.

HOUSEHOLD GARBAGE

PICK UP

In accordance with By-law 2008/73, all household garbage set out for pick up must be bagged and in a receptacle.



Each household is allowed up to a maximum of four (4) receptacles not to exceed 121 liters capacity, with a maximum weight of 25 kg (55 lbs) per receptacle
